Marketplace for Kids demonstrates the special role of youth in improving the economic future of our communities.

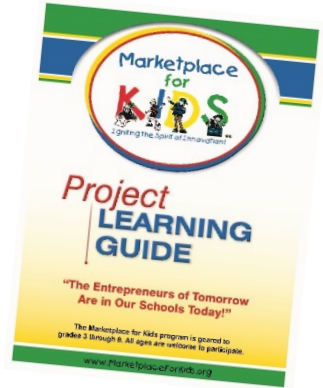

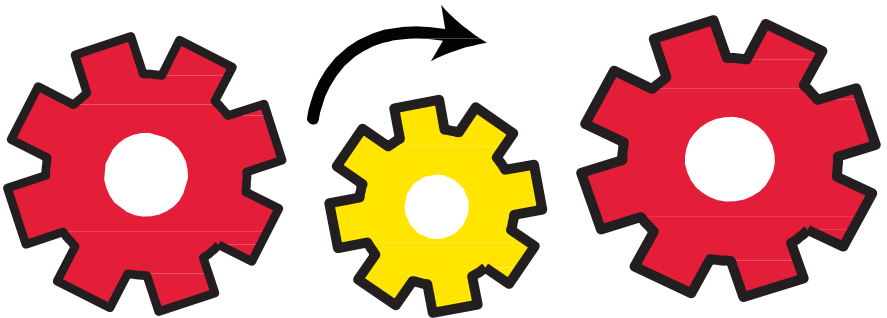
Are you helping your students develop their projects for the “Hall of Great Ideas”? The Marketplace for Kids website has many resources to help you work with your students including how to design their display boards.

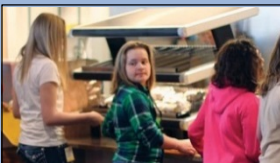

BRIGHT IDEAS SHOWCASE AND CONTEST *(The Marketplace for Kids Competitive Event)*

The **Bright Ideas Showcase and Contest** is open to all students that were in grades three through eight during the 2016-2017 school year.

This Competitive Opportunity is available to all students that are interested in taking their innovative idea to the next level! Projects will be showcased at the State Fair, July 22-30, 2017. A team of judges from the Minot, ND Chapter of SCORE and from Entrepreneurship Centers will review the projects and score them based on originality, visual presentation, student initiative and the accomplishment of the stated goal, problem or objective.

Prizes will be awarded in the following categories: Business Idea, Invention, Language/Visual Arts and Technology for each grade level participating. **Prizes** will also be awarded for Innovation in Energy, Innovation in Agriculture, and for Best New Idea. Judges may use their discretion to award additional categories.

Because this is a summer event, it's important that your student expresses their interest in possibly entering the Bright Ideas Showcase and Contest at their Education Day. This does not commit them; however, we can then send more information to your students when the school year is over. Sign up will be located in the "Hall of Great Ideas" and an invitation will be given to students during the "Hall of Great Ideas Showcase." We are encouraging all students to share this invitation with their parents.
