**Class List and Description**

**Class A: Main Street ND**

**Class B: Railroad Crossing Safety**

**Class C: Inspiration Gallery: Yesterday and Today**

Join the University of Mary student presenters in exploring the Inspiration Gallery by traveling through the following exhibits: Conflict and War, Agriculture Innovation & Newcomers and Settlement, Industry and Energy, and Our Live, Our Communities & Cultural Expressions. **(This class is limited to a capacity of 80 students per session, per presenter request.)** 19

**Class D: Walk Through Native American History in the Gallery Innovation**

Join the University of Mary students and staff as we embark on a journey through time to learn about the history and lives of Early Peoples! This gallery is devoted to the Native People of ND and highlights the beauty and breadth of the ND Heritage Center’s collections. Discover the tribes of ND both before contact with European-Americans and also as the magnificent nations they are today. **(This class is limited to a capacity of 80 students per session, per presenter request.)** 19

**Class E: Adaptation Gallery**

Dive into prehistoric times with the exciting world of fossils! Join us for a journey through time as we explore the Adaptation Gallery. This gallery is full of monstrous sea creatures, mammals, and dinosaurs that once roamed the Earth over 600 million years ago. **(This class is limited to a capacity of 40 students per session, per presenter request.)** 19

**Class F: Power Plant Puzzle**

Students will pair up in a team building exercise that utilizes their mechanical skills. They assemble nuts, bolts, linkage, and PVC into a replica of an original puzzle. **(This class is limited to a capacity of 30 students per session, per presenter request.)** 19

**Class G: Bridge Building 101**

Participants will learn about bridge structures and will build their own bridges, in small groups, out of gum drops and toothpicks. 19

**Class H: Get Moving with Therapy (Physical & Occupational)**

Students will learn various physical therapy techniques and movements. Students will demonstrate proper techniques and the benefits of mobility as we age through fun exercises and challenges. **(This class is limited to a capacity of 24 students per session, per presenter request.)** 19

**Class I: Water on Mars**

In this class students will use their critical thinking and detective skills to deduce which liquid sample is safe drinking water. We will discuss the importance of finding water on Mars. **(This class is limited to a capacity of 30 students per session, per presenter request.)** 19

**Class J: Coding with Microbits**

Join the Legacy High School Saber Cybers as they teach you coding using microbits and explain the importance of coding in our worlds. **(This class is limited to a capacity of 50 students per session, per presenter request.)** 19
