Chairman Azure was elected by his peers and serves as Board Chairman for the United Tribes of North Dakota and United Tribes Technical College. He serves on the NARF (Native American Rights Fund) board. His focus was on Native Nations voting rights and pushed for the recent voting rights lawsuit win in North Dakota with NARF. His vision is a future full of opportunities for our peoples next generation. Jamie resides in Belcourt, N.D., the heart of Turtle Island, with his two daughters, Ashlyn and Sophia.




