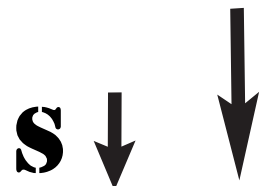
PROJECT FLOOR MAP



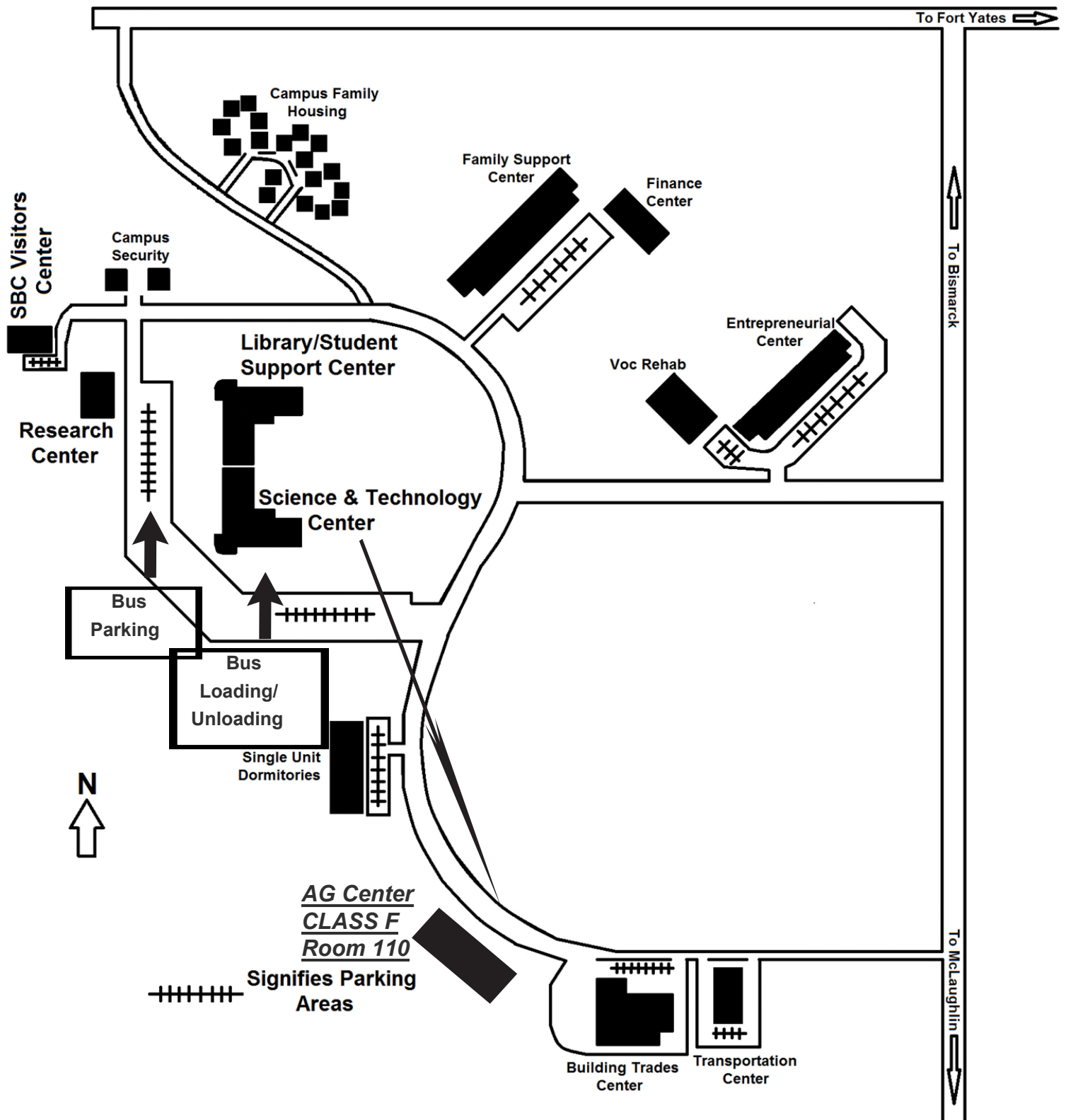
