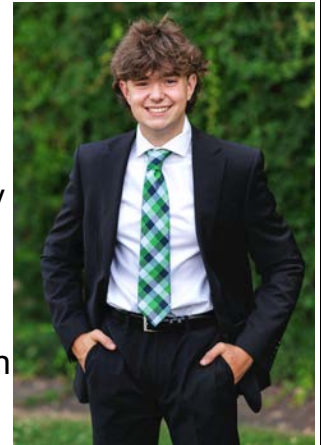
WELCOME: US SENATOR John Hoeven (video message)

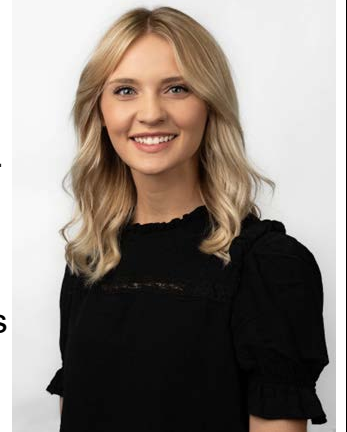

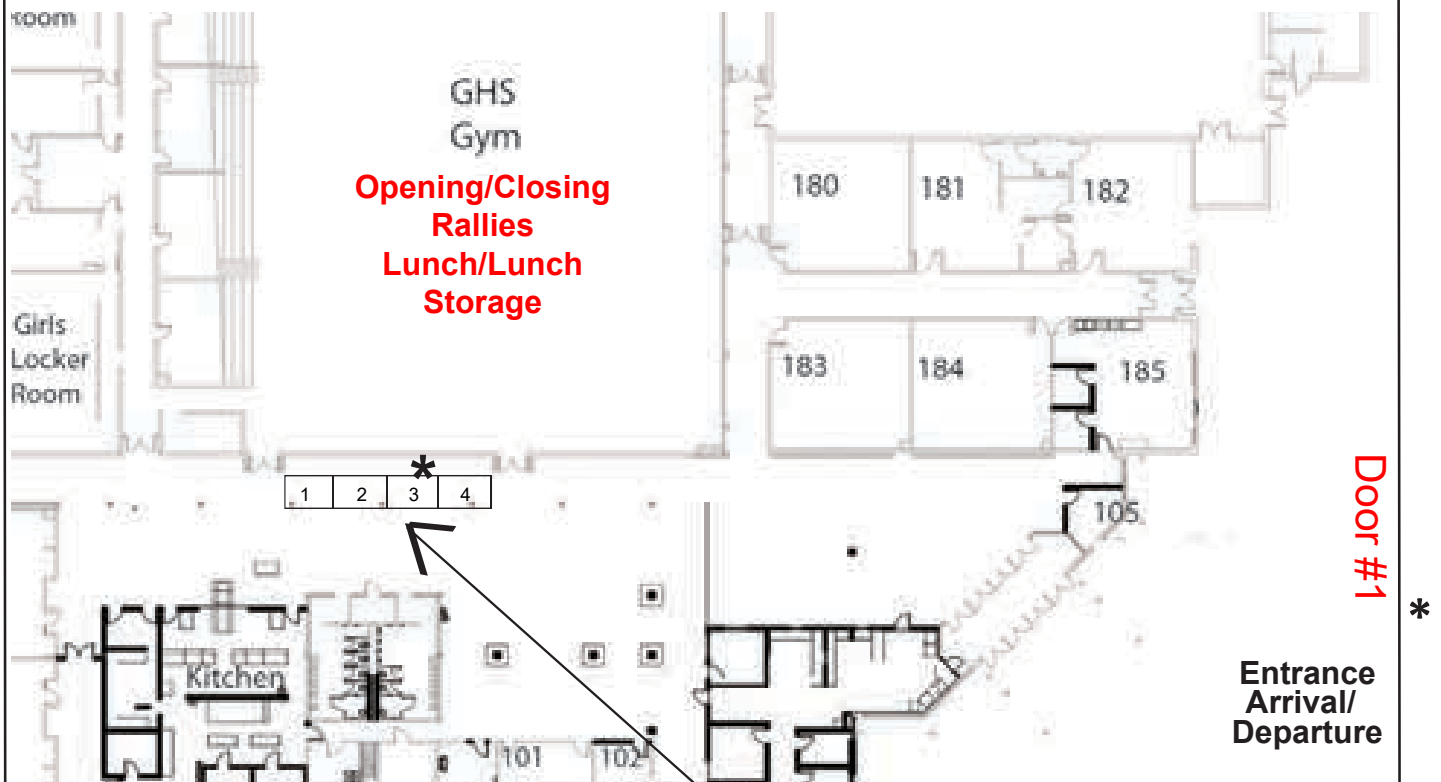

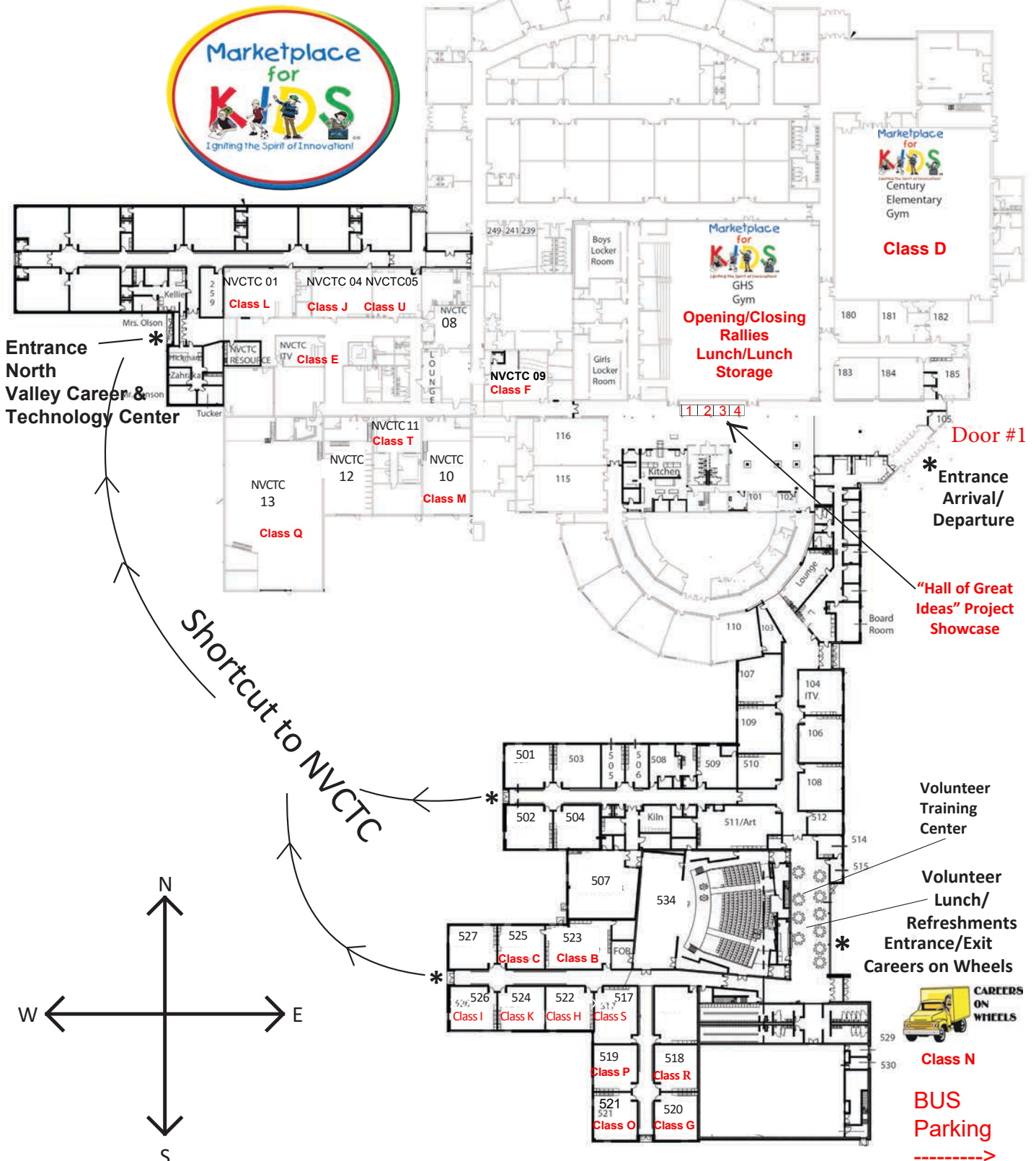
